- Discussion about needs and progress
- An open, accepting attitude
- Focus on specific and detailed analysis

Setting an effective model of student teacher evaluation:

- Continuous
- Communicative
- Constructive

Helping the supervising teacher develop perspective

Suggestions:

- Ask questions about the student teacher
- Challenge generalizations about the student teacher
- Provide time and settings for the evaluative conferences
- Be an informed use of evaluation data
- Recognize the needs of the beginning teacher and give in-serviced development some high priority attention
